Peng-Hui Wang got the degree of MD from the National Yang-Ming University School of Medicine, Taipei, Taiwan (1983-1990) and Ph.D. in the Institute of Clinical Medicine from the National Yang-Ming University, Taipei, Taiwan (1999-2002). He received his post-doctoral training at the Dr. Chang's Laboratory of the University of Rochester, NY, USA between 2002 and 2003. He is currently a Professor and Head of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Taipei Veterans General Hospital and National Yang-Ming University, Taiwan. He serves as a President of the Taiwan Association of Gynecology, and Vice President of the Taiwan Society of Perinatology, and the Directors of many academic and medical societies, including the Taiwan Association of Obstetrics and Gynecology, the Taiwan Association of Gynecologic Oncologist, the Society of Gynecologic Oncologists, ROC, the Taiwan Association of Gynecology and Minimally Invasive Surgery, and Taiwan Endometriosis Society. He is an Editor or Deputy Editor of many peer-reviewed and SCI journals, including the Journal of Chinese Medical Association, the Taiwanese Journal of Obstetrics and Gynecology, and Minimally Invasive Surgery, and also serves as editorial board in many journals addressing the research of gynecological oncology. He is also a peer-reviewer for more than 20 SCI journals. His primary research interests are focusing on studying the sialylation of gynecological cancers and experts in the management of minimally invasive surgery and hormone research. He has published more than 400 SCI papers, and majority of them were under his supervision.

Dr. Wang's exceptional achievements have been recognized by many prestigious awards, including the Golden Award of the Taiwanese Association of Obstetrics and Gynecology (2016 and 2015), the Silver Award in the Hsu Chien-Tien Foundation of Cancer Research (2015), Silver Award in the Chinese Medical Association (2014), the Silver Award of academic research in the Taipei Veterans General Hospital (2016 and 2014), and the Golden Award of the Chinese Association of Medicine-Taipei (2013), Top 10 Young in Taiwan (2004)

and many other awards.
